Narrative: On Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at 4:49pm the Essex Police Department responded to KeyBank located at 40 Pearl Street in the city of Essex Junction for a reported Bank Robbery.

A lone male entered the bank, approached a bank teller claiming to have an explosive device, and demanded money. The suspect was provided an undisclosed amount of money and exited the bank onto Pearl Street. He was seen leaving the bank on foot in an unknown direction of travel. There were no customers inside the bank at the time and no employees were injured as a result of this incident.

The suspect was described as a white male, slender build, between 5'9" – 6 feet tall, brown hair, and brown eyes. He was described to be wearing a dark colored hoodie, black facial covering, dark colored buttoned up shirt with a collar. The shirt had a checkered pattern with dark squares with a red outline. The suspect was seen carrying an orange reusable Hannaford grocery bag.

The investigation is in the beginning stages and further information will be shared when possible.

Anyone with information related to this incident or who may have been in the area and observed anything suspicious at the time of the incident is asked to contact the Essex Police Department.
