On March 19, 2025, at 6:55 am the Essex Police responded to a reported assault that occurred in an apartment located at 8 Railroad Avenue within the City of Essex Junction. When officers arrived on scene, they were able to assist two victims and additional occupants, and their pets to safety.

The assailant was identified as [REDACTED] (33) of Essex Junction. [REDACTED] barricaded himself inside the residence for nearly 4 hours until he surrendered peacefully.

An Essex Police negotiator was able to establish contact with the subject while additional resources were called to assist. The resources included Essex PD K9 Nova and the Vermont State Police that assisted by providing technical assistance with the use of their unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) that was used for an interior search of the residence.

[REDACTED] was taken into custody and transported to UVM Medical Center at his request to be evaluated for injuries he alleged he sustained during the initial reported assault. [REDACTED] was later released from the medical center and transported to the Essex Police Department for processing.

[REDACTED] was charged with Burglary, 2nd Degree Aggravated Domestic Assault, Aggravated Assault and Violation of Conditions of Release.

[REDACTED] was ordered held without bail by the Honorable Judge Pacht and is due in Court March 20, 2025.
